

Information for Primary 5G Parents.

This sheet provides you with information about what your child will be learning this term, and shows next steps in their learning. We would encourage you to talk about this with your child, and where possible, to assist them with their learning at home.

Maths & Numeracy

During our daily C.L.I.N.T. maths sessions we look at jigsaw numbers to 1,000, using 'find the gap' to subtract money and introducing the 8 times table. Every **Tuesday** we will complete a C.L.I.C. maths sheet to show our understanding and every **Friday** we will try our 'Big Maths, Beat That' challenge to show how much quicker we are getting at recalling simple addition and multiplication facts.

Hexagons - multiplying and dividing using our 8 and 9 x tables. length, 2D and 3D shapes
Shapes, Equivalent fractions.

Pentagons - looking at solving word problems using multiplying and dividing. We will also be multiplying and dividing using our 8 and 9 x tables. as well as word problems involving length.

Rectangles - concentrating on dividing by 2,3, 4 and 5 and relating this to fractions. We are also revising time and money. We continue to focus on mental maths strategies.



Language & Literacy



Spelling - every Monday we introduce our spelling words and throughout the week we complete activities to help us develop our understanding of spelling patterns, word usage and meaning. On Friday we complete a spelling test and dictation.

Reading - we are reading Charlotte's Web novel in small groups. Each group member will be responsible for reading chapters at home and creating different questions ready for the next Literature Circle meeting each Monday. We will continue to develop fluency and reading skills such as 'finding the main idea'

Writing - We will look at different examples of functional writing and develop our own skills in writing these types of texts. As we are enjoying reading Charlotte's Web, we are going to write our own adventure stories.

Our homework tasks are given out each Monday and need to be brought back to school every Friday morning. With thanks.
