

Information for Primary 2/3 Parents.

This sheet provides you with information about what your child will be learning this term, and shows next steps in their learning. We would encourage you to talk about this with your child, and where possible, assist them with learning at home.

Maths & Numeracy

This term we will be learning about the different ways we can measure. This will include measuring length, volume, capacity and area. It will be fun to use these skills in real life contexts and using the outdoors to support our learning. We will also be exploring and identifying 2d and 3d shapes and looking at their properties. P2/3 will also be looking at symmetry. We will continue to develop our problem solving skills and will be recalling the facts of the 2,5 and 10 times tables. P3 will also continue to practise the 3 and 4 times tables.. We will continue to practice our Learn-It's in order to beat our Big Maths Beat That scores through our daily CLIC sessions.



Language & Literacy



Primary 2/3 will be reading 'The Butterfly Lion' by Michael Morpurgo this term. We will be introducing new vocabulary and enhancing our existing reading skills. We will be extending our comprehension skills and developing an understanding of what we have read through discussing texts and answering questions about these. We will be challenged with analysing and evaluating questions. We will continue to build on our grammar knowledge by exploring singular and plural, speech bubbles and speech marks. We will learn how to spot these in the texts that we read and use these in our writing too. We will be learning about non-fiction texts and reading a variety of these to enhance our knowledge of headings, contents pages, page numbers and index pages.

Other Class Information

This term our topic is Native American Indians. We will be exploring the history of the Native American culture and traditions as part of our class learning. We will be looking at how the Natives used the land and animals to their advantage and compare this to our own daily lives. We will be completing various arts and crafts activities as well as building our own tipi's and totem poles. In P.E will be taking part in athletic activities such as running, jumping and throwing. This helps us to prepare for potted sports and competitive races on sports day - we are hoping to win lots of house points! As part of our R.M.E topic we will be focusing on Sukkot to develop our knowledge of other religions and cultures. We will be producing a range of art related activities to consolidate our learning. We will be focusing on 'Changes' as we begin our transition to our next stage in June.
