

# Information for Primary 3 Parents.

This sheet provides you with information about what your child will be learning this term, and shows next steps in their learning. We would encourage you to talk about this with your child, and where possible, assist them with learning at home.

## Maths & Numeracy

Primary 3 are working hard this term and we will be learning about length, weight and volume. We will also be learning about positional movement. Throughout this term we will be using addition, subtraction, multiplication and division when solving a variety of word problems. We will continue to develop a range of different mental strategies to help us. We are also developing our skills through the BIG MATHS programme, learning about portioning numbers, number bonds to 100 and continuing to reinforce the 2, 5 and 10 times table.



## Language & Literacy



Primary 3 are working very hard on their reading skills. Pupils will continue to bring home their reading book to share with you on a Monday having worked on it previously. We will be exploring texts particularly Matilda carefully in order to answer more complex questions. In writing lessons, we will be focussing on both functional writing linked to our minibeast topic and further developing our skills of describing characters and setting in imaginative writing. Throughout any piece of writing, we will continue to focus on the use of adjectives, connectives, full stops and capital letters.

## Other Class Information

Our topics this term are Minibeasts and Shabbat and we are enjoying these so far. We will be exploring these topics further through a range of Expressive Art activities such as Art and Drama and Music with Mr McDowall and Mrs McGhee.

We will also be taking part in target setting activities each week. We will think carefully about what we need to work on to reach our personal goals.

We go to PE with Mrs Sutherland every week and we are learning lots of new skills in athletics for Sports Day.

In HWB, we are learning about germs and how to maintain good personal hygiene. As you can see, Term 4 is very busy and full of exciting learning experiences.
