

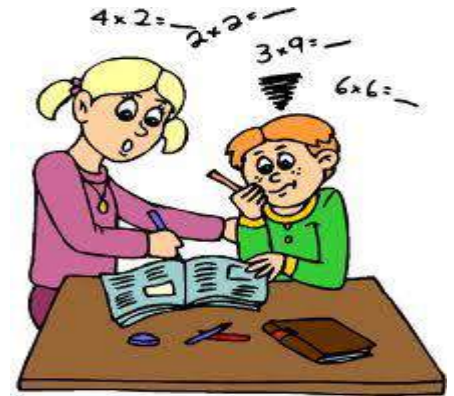
Information for Primary 1 Parents.



This sheet provides you with information about what your child will be learning this term, and shows next steps in their learning. We would encourage you to talk about this with your child, and where possible, to assist them with their learning at home.

Maths & Numeracy

We are going to be working hard on developing our mental maths skills for addition within 10. We will also be exploring a variety of 3D shapes and their properties: cubes, cuboids, cones, cylinders and spheres. At home I can look out for 3D shapes around me, I can also discuss whether these stack, roll or slide. Soon we will be exploring the language of length and weight through measuring items around the classroom, outside and even parts of our bodies!



Language & Literacy



We are continuing to practise all the sounds we have learned so far and are beginning to make words with these independently. We are having a go at writing on our own and enjoy telling the teacher and our peers about our stories. We are blending our sounds when reading, helping us to read words within sentences. We are doing this through our reading books and our language activities. We will be enjoying Julia Donaldson stories and exploring rhyming through these. Soon we will be learning our alphabet (upper case) and matching them to the sounds that we know (lower case). We could sing the alphabet song at home! We are choosing books from our school library and we will be bringing these home to enjoy with our families.

We are currently learning how we grow and change as we get older and we will be learning how to look after a baby.
