

Information for Primary 2 Parents

This sheet provides you with information about what your child will be learning this term, and shows next steps in their learning. We would encourage you to talk about this with your child, and where possible, assist them with learning at home.

Maths & Numeracy

Term Three

This term Primary 2 will be focusing on time. We will be learning to tell the time using o'clock, half past, quarter to/ past using an analogue and digital clock. We will also be looking at time intervals and time equivalents.

We will be exploring information handling and looking at different ways to record data by creating a variety of different graphs. We will be developing our mental maths strategies each day and trying to improve our recall of the Learn-It's to beat our Big Maths Beat That scores.



Language & Literacy



Term Three

We will begin this term by investigating different types of poetry. We will develop our listening and talking skills further by reciting a Scottish poem. We will even write some poems of our own.

We will continue to work on our comprehension skills and understanding of what we have read through discussing texts and answering questions about these.

To make our imaginative writing more interesting we will explore beginning, middle and end. We will be using adjectives to create detailed descriptions of character, setting and plot.

Other Class Information

Term Three

This term our topics are weather and forces. We will be carrying out various experiments to investigate forces and how they work. The class will be looking at the water cycle, measuring rainfall and delivering a weather forecast. As part of our homework, we will be researching the climates in different countries.

Through Health and Wellbeing we will be focussing on 'I wonder'. We will be using our questioning skills to demonstrate our thinking. In P.E. we will be working on our gymnastics skills. We will be balancing, rolling, jumping and turning.

As Easter is fast approaching we will be exploring the Easter story with Mr Russell in more depth during RME. We will also be looking at 'Old Testament' stories and the hidden meanings in them.

For technologies we will be linking with data handling in maths to create our own charts and graphs through ICT. We will be learning to save a document and learn how to use a search engine safely.
