<p><b>Literacy</b></p> <p><b>Spelling</b></p> <p><u>ILT - spell, use and define my spelling words.</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Look, Cover, Write and Check your spelling words in your jotter (copy out 3 times).</li> <li>Write a sentence for 4 of your spelling words</li> <li>Create a wordsearch with all of your spelling words hidden in it.</li> </ul> <p><b>Grammar</b></p> <p><b>Red Group - Special Naming Words</b></p> <p><u>ILT - identify and use special naming words correctly and know that they should have a capital letter.</u></p> <p><b>Yellow Group - Conjunctions</b></p> <p><u>ILT - identify conjunctions and use them to connect two shorter sentences.</u></p> <p><b>Writing</b></p> <p><u>ILT - write a formal letter to someone I admire.</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pupils should think about the letter we wrote to Sir Chris Hoy last week and now choose someone they admire and write a letter to them explaining why they admire them so much.</li> <li>Pupils should include why they admire that person, what they would like the person to do e.g. if it is an author could they visit the class, if it is a famous footballer could they visit them and have a football training session.</li> </ul> <p><b>Handwriting</b></p> <p><u>ILT - form and join my letters neatly and correctly.</u></p> <p><u>P2 - lv and hu</u></p> <p><u>P3 - be and bl</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pupils should copy out the letter pattern 8 times</li> <li>Pupils should then write out 3 different words 3 times each that contain the letter pattern.</li> </ul>	<p>Spelling words have already been provided home.</p> <p>Jotters / Paper Could be done on an IPAD notes section.</p> <p>Worksheets have been provided or uploaded to the school website.</p> <p><a href="https://www.topmarks.co.uk/english-games/7-11-years/writing">https://www.topmarks.co.uk/english-games/7-11-years/writing</a></p> <p>This writing activity on Topmarks may help with this task.</p>

<b>Numeracy</b>	
<p>P2 and P3</p> <p>Fractions</p> <p><b><u>ILT - recognise what is meant by a <math>\frac{1}{2}</math></u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pupils to play any of the fractions games from topmarks.</li> <li>Using material found in the home children should split piles of pasta, pens, toys etc in half noting how many they had to start with and how many each person ends up with.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Number Skills</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sumdog Challenge which will be created by Mrs Paterson. Areas covered could include, farming, Pharaoh's, Gods and Goddesses, Egyptian Fashion, Food - the list is endless.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>French</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Continue to practise your French numbers from 0-12 and beyond if you are looking for a challenge.
