Purple-

- Place value in decimal numbers addition and subtraction of decimal numbers.
- Measure- converting between units of length- m-cm, cm-m, m-km, cm-mm, mm-cm

Orange-  
ILT. multiply and divide by 10/ ILT. add and subtract using a formal method.

- Corresponding work set for all groups using SumDog and Education City.
- Children can also access MathsWorkout for corresponding topics.
- Hit the Button to be used for multiplication revision.

Purple-

- Work set through Education City and Sumdog.
- Children can access topics on MathsWorkout.
- Revise all known tables.
