This sheet provides you with information about what your child will be learning this term, and shows next steps in their learning. We would encourage you to talk about this with your child, and where possible, to assist them with their learning at home.

Maths & Numeracy

In Primary 7, all groups are continuing to work hard on 'Big Maths' CLINT sessions. The main focus this term is on angles, area, circles and coordinates. In addition to this, we will continue to reinforce and consolidate place value alongside fractions, decimals and percentages. All homework tasks will consolidate class learning. These will be issued on Monday and will be expected to be completed to a high standard for Thursday.

Due to the current situation, homework tasks will continue to all be allocated online, using either Sumdog or Education City as our platform. P7 teachers set and monitor the homework very closely so it is important that this online work is completed to the same standard as jotter work would be. Thank you for your understanding.



Language & Literacy



Primary 7 are continuing to work on up levelling their use of adjectives and adverbs to improve their writing. We are focusing on imaginative and persuasive writing this term. We shall finish reading 'Goodnight Mr Tom' this term, which is linked to our WW2 topic. We will continue to use this as a stimulus for some writing and comprehension tasks, such as summarising and paraphrasing. Bug Club will continue this term and pupils will be asked to complete homework tasks online. Spelling words are uploaded to the P7 Microsoft Teams page and pupils are encouraged to choose an active spelling activity from the page to consolidate their new words. Spelling assessments will continue to be carried out every Friday.

Other Class Information

This term, Primary 7 shall complete the interdisciplinary topic, "WW2". Following this, the pupils will delve into the world of Science where we will explore senses and adaptations. This term we shall continue Sumdog and Bug Club homework. If children experience any difficulties completing this, then we strongly advise that they let their teacher know. Homework is an important part of young people's learning and supports what we are doing in the classroom. Please support your child's learning by ensuring it is completed to a good standard and completed on time. We will continue to use Microsoft Teams for communication with all pupils and to set additional homework tasks. Through ICT, we will continue to explore word processing skills to enable pupils to use the software accurately both in school and at home.
