**Christianity: Beliefs**

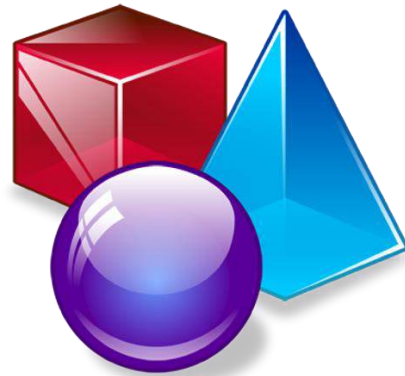
**ILT - describe some beliefs Christians have about God and Jesus by exploring Bible Stories**

**Health and Wellbeing**

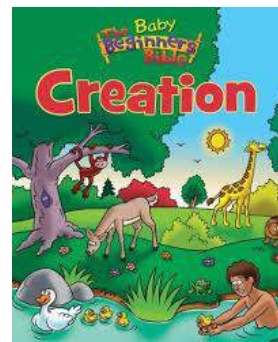

At the end of this month we celebrate the birth of Robert Burns the world famous Scottish poet who was born in Alloway.

- Can you create some Burns / Scottish themed pieces of art for me?
- (1) You might want to go for a walk to Burns Cottage / Around Alloway and take a paper and pencil with you and create a pencil drawing of the cottage, monument, Auld Kirk or Brig O Doon. There are lots of lovely Burns Related things to see in and around Alloway and this will get you out of the house for a few hours.
- (2) Many people in Scotland wear a tartan dress or kilt to celebrate Burns Night, research any tartans linked to your family and create a colourful tartan kilt of your own.
- (3) Thistles are the national flowers of Scotland, can you create a Thistle of your own.



## Science - Weather

Our new topic for this term is weather, we will be looking at climate zones around the world, how weather is recorded and reported and what Natural Disasters are, what causes them and where in the world they happen.

- Watch the weather forecast every day this week - look for the symbols used to show the different types of weather - were the weather reports accurate. Keep a diary of what the weather is actually like, remember to do this at the same time every day. I have uploaded a sheet to help with this.
- Choose a city in a different country and track what their weather is like. It might be interesting to choose a country in the Southern Hemisphere as although it is our winter it is their summer so the weather should be different.
